

## Slide #2 – Together, W.E. S.E.A.: Accessing Recovery Before Wellness Becomes Reactive (How this is being approached)

### W: What's Next Previews

Attention begins shifting from infrastructure availability toward infrastructure accessibility. The emerging question is not whether assets exist, but whether communities can realistically engage with them over time.

### E: Enhancements

Adaptation dynamics provide a useful lens for examining infrastructure decisions. The focus expands beyond utilization metrics toward the conditions that support sustained participation and recovery.

### S: Stewardship

Infrastructure stewardship extends beyond preserving assets. It includes periodically revisiting the assumptions that connect those assets to the outcomes they were intended to influence.

### E: Engagement

Different stakeholders experience the same environment differently. Understanding those perspectives often reveals tensions that remain invisible within planning documents and utilization reports.

### A: Agility tips

Conditions evolve. Communities evolve. Accessibility assumptions that once appeared reasonable may gradually become misaligned with lived realities if left unexamined.
