Patterns & Experiences

Has **Cant** quietly entered the conversation?

Not through deterioration.

Not through failure.

But through growing distance between what exists and what is *actually* experienced.

When participation remains uneven despite expanded access, what assumptions are shaping how success is being interpreted?

Where might effort continue moving while outcomes remain largely unchanged?

Is progress occurring – or is the system gradually moving sideways around barriers that remain unresolved?

What conditions are being measured because they are visible, while other conditions remain influential precisely because they are harder to see?

When infrastructure appears successful on paper, how often are the underlying assumptions revisited before Cant's subtle forms of drift – scope, accountability, expectations, or interpretation – become embedded in the system itself?
